Practice-oriented co-creation



CLIFF OSWICH is a Professor in Organization Theory on Cass Business Scholl in London. Cliff's research focuses on the application of aspects of discourse, dramaturgy, tropes, narrative and rhetoric to the study of organizations and organizing. He is particularly interested in the study of leadership processes, employee engagement, and organizational change. He has published over 120 academic articles and contributions to edited volumes, including contributions to Academy of Management Review, Human Relations, and British Journal of Management, Organization, and Organization Studies. Beyond his academic responsibilities, Cliff has also undertaken a variety of consultancy projects, senior coaching activities and executive development assignments with a number of high profile corporate clients.

Marie Kronquist is a modern buddhist teacher who has worked with meditation, silence, mental training and mindfulness for 15 years.
